Paul Phillips has been performing Russian, Ukrainian and Gypsy folk music for over 50 years. A founding member and long time Artistic Director of the Houston Balalaika Society, he was the first U.S. citizen to study at the Kiev Institute of Culture.

For 10 years, Paul operated a Gypsy Camp at the Texas Renaissance Festival. In addition to his professional ensemble, The Caravan, over the years, he has created and directed numerous specialty groups, including the Potemkin Pops Balalaikas, the Rusty Shekel Klezmer Consortium, the Hooliganey Slavic Instrument Ensemble and Rhythm Band, and Zubal's Kapella.

Since 1987, Paul's periodic "Jamming" workshops at BDAA Conventions, have been well and enthusiastically received.
